

RALLY RULES

1. The British in the Blue Ridge ("BIBR") Rally is a family event and GABMA requests that all members and guests respect the rules presented here and those of the campground. In the event of a conflict between the two sets of rules, the most stringent shall apply.
2. REGISTRATION: The BIBR Rally officially opens at 8:00 AM on Friday, June 5, 2009. You will be permitted to camp after 6:00 PM on the evening of June 5, 2009 (the Thursday before the BIBR Rally officially opens) at no extra charge. However, earlier arrivals must pay the campground their normal daily fee (i.e., Wednesday night and earlier). GABMA will man the front gate from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM on Friday and Saturday. All campsites must be vacated by 3:00 PM on Sunday. Anyone staying after Sunday must make his or her own arrangements with the Campground.
3. NO RESERVED CAMPSITES: Campsites will be assigned on a first come, first served basis in the areas set aside for BIBR participants. We are sharing the campground with others who have reserved portions of the campground. We will make every attempt to keep vendors in the same area. The campsites are large enough to "buddy up"; please consider sharing your electric hook-ups.
4. QUIET TIME: Quiet time is from 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM, so please, no lights, music, radios, generators or loud pipes during these hours.
5. TRANSPORTATION: Speed limit throughout the park is **5 MPH** in the camping areas. Unlicensed vehicles are not allowed in the park. Do not allow unlicensed drivers to operate any motor vehicle in the park.
6. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE RESTRICTED TO THE CAMPSITES.
7. NO DOGS ALLOWED.
8. CHILDREN: Parents are responsible for the actions, behavior and safety of their children. PLEASE SUPERVISE YOUR CHILDREN AT PLAY AND AT THE POOL.
9. PERSONAL CONDUCT: Behavior amounting to nuisance, hazardous conduct, or failure to comply with all Federal, State, and local laws is grounds for eviction from the Campground. Each camper is responsible for their own conduct, and the conduct of their children and guests.
10. POOL: The pool is open for swimming 12 noon to 7 PM. Observe pool rules and SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. NO LIFEGUARD IS PROVIDED. PARENTS MUST SUPERVISE THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES. NO UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN UNDER 14. NO ALCOHOL IN THE POOL AREA.
11. TABLES IN THE CAMPING AREA: A limited number of picnic tables are available at the campsites so please bring your own camp table and chairs.
12. CAMPFIRES: All campfires must be contained and all debris remaining must be cleaned up and removed from the camping area. An adult must be present at all times to attend the fire. There will be no unattended fires. Unattended campfires must be extinguished.

13. TRASH AND WASTE: Do not dump trash or wastewater on the ground or in streams. Violators will be asked to leave. GABMA will provide each camper with trash bags. Please place your trash in the trash bags, tie them closed, and take them to the dumpsters at the end of Doe Lane Drive. Police your campsite area, and please clean up before leaving.
14. MESSAGES: GABMA will provide a bulletin board for messages at the front gate. We have no way of locating campers to deliver messages, so check the front gate daily for messages. Emergency messages may be phoned to the camp office at (706) 896-2274. NOTE THAT THE PAY PHONES HAVE BEEN REMOVED FROM THE BATHHOUSES.
15. AMBULANCE: Should you have a medical emergency, call 911 ON YOUR CELLULAR PHONE for an ambulance. The campground is about 5 miles from the nearest hospital.
16. SECURITY: Night security will be provided. If you have a problem during daylight hours, come to the front gate for help or tell a GABMA Officer.
17. RV AND MOTORHOME SITES: All sites with sewer hook-up are large and have easy access. However, **due to the increasing cost of utilities**, anyone who occupies an RV or Motorhome site must pay Bald Mountain Campground a **\$15.00/night fee** for Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights.
18. VENDORS AND VENDOR AREAS: All vendors must set up in the designated vendor sites, with water and electric hook-ups.
19. BATHS AND SHOWERS: Rest rooms with heated showers are available. The facilities are new. There is limited hot water, so please be courteous. Turn off the lights when leaving. **KEEP THE SHOWER AND REST ROOM AREAS CLEAN. VANDALISM WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
20. LOSS, DAMAGE CLAIMS: The campground and GABMA are not responsible for loss, damage or claims for damages for property of campers due to fire, theft, accident or other causes.
21. DISREGARD: Disregard for any one of the above rules will be sufficient reason for terminating a camper's stay WITHOUT REFUND. Rules violations will result in a forfeiture of all fees paid to GABMA and/or the campground. Management and GABMA reserve the right to add or amend these rules as circumstances require.
